We moved quickly to investigate and found that the student did have a plastic gun in his possession. At no time were any students ever threatened or in any harm. We were able to address this situation quickly and efficiently, and the student will receive disciplinary action.

The safety of our students is our top priority. Therefore, weapons of any kind, even plastic replicas are prohibited on any school property. Per Hillsboro ISD Schools policy and as noted in the Handbook, we will take appropriate action if any student is found to possess a knife, gun or similar item. I encourage you to share this policy with your child and talk with them about the importance of responsible and respectful behavior.
